#### What makes RicoRock different?

Faux rock has a bad reputation because there are a lot of rock products made of resins and plastics that are not suitable for outdoor waterfalls. Ironically we make excellent Urethane panels (see pgs 48, 49) but do not make waterfalls from this product because sunlight and pool chemicals deteriorate the surface in just a few years. Our waterfalls are made of a **high tech concrete mix** using materials

similar to those found in natural stone and the reduced weight is a major improvement for shipping and installation. RicoRock designs have contoured shapes that direct even a small water flow into a nice cascade.. Plus they don't leak. Over 12,000 installations of our product in the past 15 years proves it is the preferred method of pool waterfall construction for hundreds of companies.



#### How It's Made

RicoRock waterfalls have realistic character and detail because they are molded from natural rock formations. Our R&D process relies on decades of experience and our designs include cascades, sheet waterfalls, and grottos in several rock styles.

#### Who Installs?

RicoRock is sold wholesale thru pool product distributors. The majority of our dealers are pool companies who only install for their own projects.

We have a network of independent contractors that construct custom projects or assist pool companies on complex projects and this usually involves travel.

#### Installation for Waterfall Kits

Kits have individual cast boulders that weigh up to 150 lbs for most designs. Masonry skills are needed for a permanent installation on a concrete pad. Multiple base pieces allow for flexible installation.





#### **Custom Installation**

Custom projects are labor intensive and require special skills to properly install using steel reinforced concrete.



Powerful, but tranquil at the same time, the 4 FT Double is our most popular waterfall kit.

This double waterfall is perfectly scaled for a swimming pool because it is wide and has several layers that create a sheet waterfall on the left and a cascade on the right. Multiple base pieces allow it to be installed on a radius or corner.




For nature lovers there is nothing like a relaxing boulder waterfall on a pool. RicoRock is easier to install than natural boulders, without the leaks.

This mid-sized waterfall has been a classic for many years and features a clear sheet waterfall if there is enough water flow.





# **Stream Section**

STREAM

Want to walk in front of the waterfall instead of behind it? The Stream Section is usually installed with the Tennessee Ledger Waterfall kit and Steppers.

The top color pattern is Western Sandstone and the bottom pic is Texas Fieldstone.

The Stream Section has a main piece that weighs about 250lbs set in a thick layer of mortar. Four Steppers are used as a lift kit and transition to the deck.







# 4 Piece Ledger


Simple is sometimes better. This low profile waterfall is a best seller because it is a good size for most pools and the splash of the cascade has a natural effect.




# Florida 3 Step

WF FL3S

Even a small waterfall adds sparkle and fun to a backyard pool. Usually, the existing pool pump is diverted to run the waterfall so there is no additional operating expense.

There is a 3-inch lip on the front piece to make the waterfall look built-in to an existing deck. The waterfall is finished on the backside and plumbing is completely hidden.

### **Stairway Waterfall**

The Stairway Waterfall is a simple cascade of water that is an affordable alternative to a masonry waterfall. It is DIY friendly—no mortar needed and there is a large access panel on the back for plumbing. It weighs 200-300 lbs so it is inherently stable although it can be secured to a deck. 5ft 8in wide x 3ft 10in deep x 28in high





### Harambe Waterfall

Does this look like the rounded shoulders of a great ape to anyone else? Just a small playful waterfall that will add fun to the pool for decades. 70in wide x 45in deep x 24in high

## Caleb's Spring

This low profile waterfall weighs about 200 lbs and looks good with a low water flow but can handle 20-40 gpm for a whitewater cascade. All of these waterfalls are inherently stable because of their weight but the joint where they meet the deck is usually caulked or mortared.

### **Jumper Plus**

The Jumper Plus features a small cascade on one side. Shown here with optional LO3 boulder.

The 2 inch return pipe is hidden with small flat rock, included, and plumbing in backside is hidden with small hollow rock. The bottom edge is 4 inches wide so it can be mortared to a deck.

### **Jumping Rocks**

Jumping into a pool is one of the most enjoyable things about having a pool and a single Jump Rock or a waterfall like the 4 Ft Double shown here makes it easy. The surface of RicoRock has a better grip than natural rock and feet first jumping is much safer than a diving board.

We encourage everyone to post and enforce rules about head first diving since it is not easy to use good judgement when you are having fun.





# 9 Inch Coping/Waterline

RicoRock Coping/Waterline creates a rustic old world look and is user friendly. The **9 Inch Coping** was used on the beam with **8 Inch Tile** used as pavers and **3 x 9 Inch coping** used on the outside edge. A mixture of the new Natural Color Patterns is shown here with no added Acrylic Stain (more about color on pg 50.)

Safety codes require a handhold in some situations. Coping can work but it should slope towards the pool to prevent seepage.



8 Piece set covers 8 linear feet

**Waterproofing** should be applied to the pool shell prior to mortaring waterline rock of any kind. Two coats are needed. RicoRock Waterproofing is a fast drying hydraulic cement formula available in 5-gallon pails. Our coping products can be cut with a grinder type tool.





Installation Tips

A rich mortar applied to the beam and the coping will make a durable bond. A mastic joint like Deck-O-Seal is recommended where the deck meets the coping (right).



# 13 Inch Coping/Waterline

CWL 13IN



The 13 Inch Coping/Waterline is larger; it's designed to cover 12 inch pool beams and extend below the waterline. It works well with in-ground pools, both new construction and remodels.

9 Pieces cover 6 linear feet. Intended for vinyl liner pools, remodels and installations with pool tile. Using RicoRock coping allows for design harmony by not having too many hardscape treatments. All RicoRock products are made of a high density concrete mix that resists damage to freeze thaw.







These large boulders below make for good seating or jumping rocks. Both weigh about 250 lbs and have a better texture than most natural stones.

**NOTE:** Boulders sit level with a 2 inch wide edge on the bottom that can sit on a concrete deck or can be secured with construction adhesive or mortar. Two inch overhang over the pool is recommended; minimum 4 ft water depth. NO DIVING signs needed for shallow pools.

### **Submerged Boulders**

Rocks intended to go underwater are special order and are sold hollow. Dealers must fill the boulders with concrete to avoid stagnant water.

### Quartz Boulders

Mostly smaller boulders with lots of hard edges and detail. These boulders are also used in the 3 Ft Modular & 4 Ft Double Waterfall Kits.

As Notched Boulders they extend 9 inches from the beam and go below waterline. Also available Filled with a flat bottom so they can be mortared to a flat deck or stacked.




Lighting adds interest to the waterfalls in the evening hours. LED lights work well but some models do not meet local pool codes. 1/2" LED lights can be installed to sync with pool lights from several manufacturers.

Newer RicoRock kits have channels so light cords can be hidden and changed out as needed. Light cords should go in a flexible conduit, 1" diameter needed for some LED's









### **Cheatham Funhouse**

This remodel of an existing pool features a wide variety of RicoRock products. There is minimal Acrylic color, none at all in the coping. A construction video is available at: https://ricorock.com/cheatham

# **Loveseat Grotto**




Want a cozy place to sit behind a waterfall sheet? This waterfall is designed to fit around a pool seat but can be adapted to fit a radius or other application.

Engineered construction with #4 rebar and five inches of concrete provides a high level of safety.

This kit features cast rock pieces on top and bottom with a steel reinforced concrete core.

The Loveseat Grotto is available with either a 24" or 36" weir.

# 5 Foot Triple

Besides a dramatic main waterfall sheet, there are two side waterfalls as part of this waterfall design. The rocks were molded from Limestone boulders so it is big and blocky.

This is an older model design but was recently upgraded to be lighter with an improved plumbing layout. This model needs at least 80 GPM water flow for a robust sheet waterfall.


The grotto lid has steel reinforced concrete so it is safe for over 500 lbs.

### Component Grotto


The Component Grotto is a **structural product** that requires experience with steel reinforced concrete to install properly.

Typical engineering is available but some cities may require wet stamped plans and codes vary.










The Component System includes various column and wall sections for the vertical support and grotto sections for the top structure.

A 9 ft wide grotto assembly is available; designed for a 6 ft wide pool seat.



#### Construction Tips

Experience with steel reinforced concrete is important and tech support from experienced installers is available. This is a very efficient structural grotto, about 2 yards of concrete mix is required, 2-3 days to install.

The Foundation should be a concrete pad, if a 4 inch pool deck is used it may cause stress cracks. Ideally a 6 inch pad with reinforcing is best for the combined weight of cast rock and concrete.



1. Columns are clam shell pieces wired to a rebar column.



4. Top requires 1 yard of concrete. Note T brace under front grotto.



2. Columns should be strapped and braced before filling with concrete.



5. Place weir in fresh concrete or mortar the next day.



3. Bottom grotto lids rest on columns; dowel into columns.



6. Extend plumbing into basin; set additional small boulders as needed.

### 15' Fiberglass Slide Package

Several companies offer a 15' fiberglass waterslide as their premium product but they do not have an access ladder. A Component Grotto Waterfall works well with this slide.

Image on the right shows the **deluxe package** which includes component grotto extended version, rock panels for the back side, gap rocks and 3 piece staircase.

Juan Pablo Rodriguez, right, installed this 15 Ft Slide package for South Texas Pools. Juan is an independent contractor and travels extensively to install custom residential projects from his home base in central Texas.

# 10' Fiberglass Slide Package



Image on the left shows Loveseat grotto, rocks on both sides of slide, gap rocks, and staircase up to slide with four steppers. Image on the right shows a 4 Foot Double and a Component Grotto.



## **Step Options**

**Modular Staircase Pieces** are available to be mortared in place or filled with concrete to provide access to fiberglass waterslides. All three main pieces required for a 15 ft slide and only one main piece plus steppers for other slide configurations.

Sleeves are built into the base pieces to anchor posts for handrails on either or both sides. Rails can be wood, steel or carved concrete faux wood but are not included and may be subject to local building codes.







### Steppers

Steppers are sold hollow but can be foam filled by special order. They are easy to cut and adapt to any setting.

Stepper 1 is 52" x 42" x 15" high the others are 7 1/2" high

S2 is 41" x 33" S3 is 34" x 19" S4 is 46 x 24" S5 is 49" x 42"






### Custom Concrete Steps

Rock making skills are needed to create custom steps but steppers and cast pieces for the risers simplify things and only joints and treads need hand texture.



Large fiberglass slides of 28 ft or more are available for custom projects. Deck Slides with built-in ladders are a less expensive option. Tube slides are offered by some contractors. Making the slide look built into the rock is difficult, the following page shows two techniques used by our dealers.




### Post and Beam Technique

For many years we have recommended a solid concrete backfill of castings, (see bottom of page.)

The Post and Beam Method uses 8x8x16" block as columns, rebar from the columns reinforces a beam that is hand stamped at the same level as the slide. Castings need to be cut level with the slide, the block columns should be 3 inches below the slide level.

There are many styles of castings to choose from for a slide surround but the Rushmore series works best. With Post and Beam construction there should only be a few joints that require hand texture and the top cap.






cross section of rock surround for slides Post & Beam Method


### **Custom Grottos**

A grotto adds mystery to a swimming pool and the height allows for a dramatic waterfall. Unlimited variations are possible. Usually there is 3-4 ft of head room above the water for a grotto and at least 7 ft for a walk-in cave. Large openings are needed in warm climates to allow for air circulation.









Besides the visible upgrades, this man cave in VA. features 12 ft. high ceilings, hidden doors, a bathroom, A/C and floor heat. The 34 ft span required special engineering using steel beams.


### **Custom Caves**







There are 4 main series of rock panel and boulder styles used for custom rockwork. The newest molds are Fractured Granite, FG series.

### Fractured Granite FG Series

These panels have high relief, up to 18" and are great to veneer walls because they create a 3D effect. They blend well with other panel styles.









Rushmore panels are low relief but sharp corners and are ideal for cave construction because they minimize concrete backfill and do not interfere with wall space.



Limestone panels and boulders work best horizontally because of strong strata lines.

# **C** Boulders

C boulders can create a stacked boulder effect but requires more material and longer installation time.







# **Concrete Backfill**

Backfilling GFRC castings with concrete is the standard construction method and there are several techniques commonly used. Plywood or pegboard forms can be used with plastic chairs maintaining the minimum thickness of concrete (left). Hillside construction requires caissons to anchor the structure; the cantilevered grotto lid shown here is not bonded to the pool beam to allow movement. (right).

EPS foam blocks are useful for freestanding structures (left).

Castings can be used as in-place forms and shotcrete applied to the backside for freestanding walls (right)

Plastic lathe is superior to traditional metal lathe for gaps between panels. Plastic zip ties in place of tie wire greatly reduces rust issues. (right)

Concrete can be hand mixed but a small line concrete pump is a time saver for larger projects. The area between castings is a water course area and will be waterproofed before texture. (lower left).

Hand texture of gaps is required; using a mortar the same color as the castings makes coloring easier. (lower right). Alex Rosales, lower left, is now manager of the Texas office. Sergio Torres, lower right, is the lead rock artisan for RR Construction Management, he has 35 years of experience.









This structure at our Texas location is considered a temporary structure since it is built on pallet racks bolted to a concrete foundation. It has stood 13 years without cracks or maintenance although it may not withstand hurricane conditions like the more expense heavy steel frames.











### Veneer

Our new FG castings have greatly improved the look of wall veneers because there is enough relief that elaborate steel frames are not needed for a 3-D look. The wall above is part of the wave pool at a new waterpark in Trinidad. RicoRock tech support assisted crews from Hampton Marketing Ltd.

Castings are secured every 2-3 ft with ½" anchor bolts; the small square of yellow lathe holds mortar needed to hide the exposed bolt. Randy Phillip, right, is a long time tech support person for the Caribbean based in Trinidad.





Besides urethane panels for theming effects our cast concrete products can also be used for added durability and a more realistic feel. Coping can be used for an old world masonry effect, right.

# **Climbing Walls**

Our Limestone panels have the most natural handholds; the FG and Rushmore series are more challenging and amateur rock climbers will need typical climbing wall handholds. RicoRock cast concrete product can be secured to a wood or steel frame or backfilled with concrete. Urethane panels are not a good option for climbing walls and the installer assumes all liability, we only supply product.








# Sectional 7 Foot Climber

This standard product is sold as two sections with an internal steel frame using angle iron. It can be installed with a forklift or pallet jack, maximum weight of each section is 1,500 lbs. 6ft minimum pool water depth is recommended.





### Urethane Castings Most of our panels and boulders are available in a hard shell urethane

Most of our panels and boulders are available in a hard shell urethane with foam backing; great for indoor projects but outdoors they will deteriorate with time. Our molds give the product great detail and the urethane properties make it super lightweight, only one pound per square foot. Zayvian Camacho, far right, is our primary design/ fabrication guy for this product line.










A wood frame stud wall system is the best structural support for Urethane Panels. Cutting is easy with a one handed reciprocal saw and they can be attached to a wood frame with a screw and washer although a nail gun can also be used. Cutting for a tight fit is recommended and joints can be blended with modified dry wall paste. Boulder castings work well for corners and cantilevers and several panel styles are available.







The most natural and long lasting color patterns have **integral color in the concrete**, both with our product and all other cast concrete. The two primary color patterns are **Gray Granite and Limestone**. We only use a small amount of a dark stain as an antique effect and a small amount of a Rust color for the Limestone as an accent although it can be left off by special request.

We no longer encourage dealers to add accent colors because it often is too strong and is difficult to remove. All Acrylic Stains will fade with time. The more stain that is added the more the fading will be visible; usually in a just a few years.

If a Sandstone or Fieldstone color pattern is chosen we recommend a **Sealer like Deck O Shield**, available on line or with an order. The water based sealer should be applied a week or more after installation because it protects the Acrylic Colors but also seals the mortar joints, which are sometimes a source of calcium deposits.

Other integral colors can be ordered at extra expense. Tan colors and brown tones have been used in the past, mostly on larger projects.



Like natural rock, there are many variations within each pattern. Dealers

often add accent colors but it is hard to remove the Acrylic Stain color.

#### Limestone

Our default color. An offwhite base with some rust accents.



# Gray Granite

Medium gray with antique accents.





### Western Sandstone

Western Sandstone has reddish, rust & antique notes.

#### TX Fieldstone

Strong reddish brown and rust accents with mottled antique patterns.





#### Oklahoma Sandstone

Oklahoma Sandstone has golden amber, rust & antique tones.

#### **FL Fieldstone**

Strong rust accents with black antique tones.

## Frequently Asked Questions

### How long will the color last?

The project on the right was built by our parent company over 20 years ago and has not been re-painted; the owners like the aged patina the concrete has. The accent colors we apply will fade and sometime owners want color touchups in 3-5 years; RicoRock Acrylic Stain is easy to apply and is sold retail. See our YouTube video: Rock stains by RicoRock.

### How durable is RicoRock?

Properly installed all the waterfalls are safe to climb on and the surface is not slippery like some natural rock. Because they are made of a dense concrete mix they hold up well to salt systems and pool chemicals although extremely acidic water will deteriorate any concrete surface including RicoRock.

# Can a safety cover work with a RicoRock waterfall?

Threaded inserts allow for eye bolts and a cable to secure a pool cover but these inserts must be installed at the factory, they cannot be installed on site although inserts can be drilled into surrounding deck or coping.

### Is there a warranty?

There is a five year limited warranty on RicoRock Modular Products when you register the product; it does not cover the installation portion. Our Dealers are all independent contractors and responsible for workmanship, licensing, insurance and engineering issues. Pictured on the right is our first e-mail customer from 2001.
